

High Five

*a charity quilt pattern
from Zeppelin Threads
finished size: 39.5" x 39.5"*

Materials:

- 5 fat quarters for the 25-patch squares (label A, B, C, D, E)
- 1 fat quarter for the accent squares (label F)
- 2/3 yard of a neutral color for the sashing/border (label N)
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of material for the backing
- 1/3 yard of material for the binding
- 42" x 42" square of batting

Assembly instructions:

1. Cut five 3.5" x 14" strips from each fat quarter.
2. Create five rectangles by sewing the long edges of the strips together in this order:
 - A - B - C - D - E (this makes the Q rectangle)
 - E - A - B - C - D (this makes the R rectangle)
 - D - E - A - B - C (this makes the S rectangle)
 - C - D - E - A - B (this makes the T rectangle)
 - B - C - D - E - A (and this makes the U rectangle)
3. Cut each rectangle crosswise into four 3.5" x 15.5" wide multicolor strips.
4. Assemble four identical 25-patch blocks by sewing strips together in this order:
Q - R - S - T - U

Each 25-patch should look like this when complete:

A	B	C	D	E	<- Q
E	A	B	C	D	<- R
D	E	A	B	C	<- S
C	D	E	A	B	<- T
B	C	D	E	A	<- U

5. Square the 25-patch blocks (they should be 15.5" on each side).
6. Cut nine 3.5" squares from fabric F.
7. Cut twelve 3.5" x 15.5" strips from fabric N.
8. Assemble the quilt top according to the diagram below:

11. Trim and bind.
