

# Threes, Please

A quick quilt pattern that can be completed in a weekend!

**Finished size: 43 x 46**

## Materials:

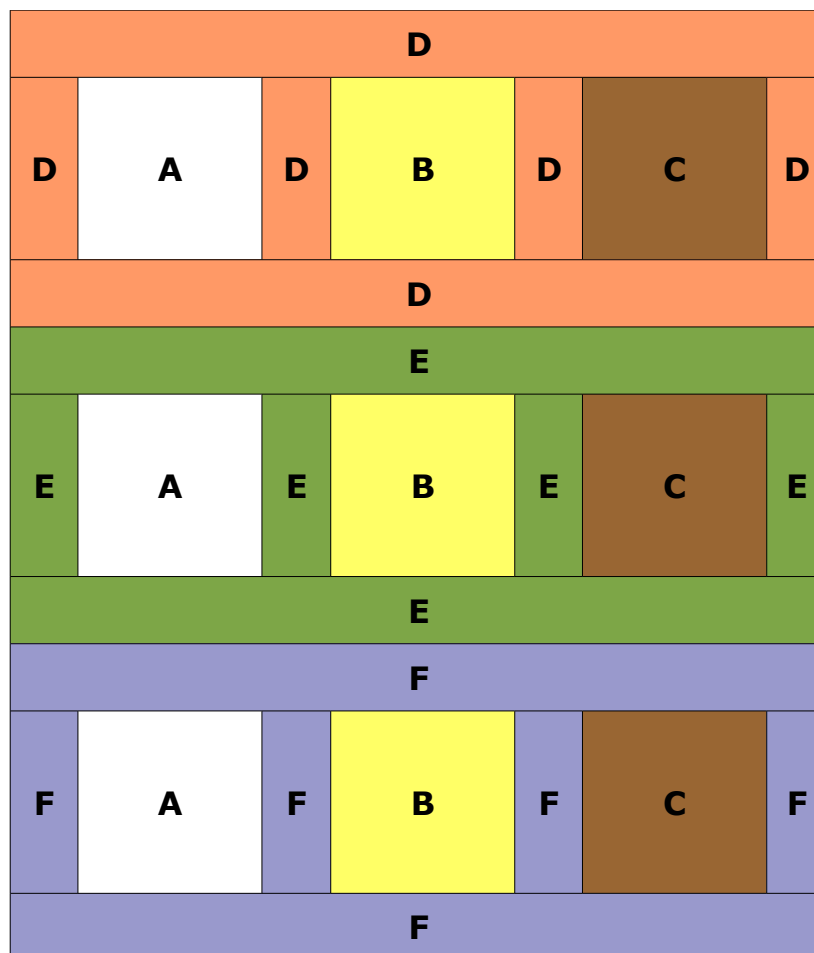
1/3 yard each of three coordinated prints (A, B, C)

1/2 yard each of three matching solids (D, E, F)

1 1/2 yard of backing (44"-45" wide)

1/2 yard of fabric for binding (for binding with 2.5" strips)

batting and thread



Friday night:

1. Cut fabric.
  - a) From each of the solids, cut:
    - Four 10" x 4" rectangles, and
    - Two 43" x 4" rectangles.
  - b) From each of the prints, cut:
    - Three 10" squares.
  - c) From the binding fabric, cut:
    - Five 2.5" wide strips.

Saturday morning:

2. Assemble the quilt top.
  - a) Following the diagram, sew 10"x4" rectangles to the 10" squares to form strips:  
DADBDCD, EAEBECE, FAFBFCF. Press seams to darkest fabric.
  - b) Sew strips together from top to bottom, according to the diagram. Press seams away from the 10" blocks. Press the DE and EF seams to darkest fabric.
3. Assemble binding.

Saturday afternoon:

4. Layer and baste.
