



This was the original drawing / sketch idea for the quilt. I pretty much kept all the ideas, except the little 3" blocks next to the bottom tree. I suppose you could add those if you prefer. My intention was that those would be drawn images with pigma pens and then colored using crayons and heat set with the iron. One little finishing element I do like is the embroidery on the tree that would say "only a vampire can love you forever" Red, of course , and in beautiful script. ☺



Here is what you don't have yet:

1. I added a row in the middle of half square triangles which give that candy stripe look. I used my darkest **fabric I** (brown) and **fabric E** (which was my Edward blue from the Edward blocks). There are 16 of them, and finished they measure 2". You can probably look up making half square triangles to size online.
2. You also see a heart block. The background was a 13" square of **fabric F** that can be sized down when you sew all the blocks together. There is a heart of yo-yos that are tacked to the solid background. The yo-yos are made out of a variety of your **fabric D**. You can also find instructions online how to make yo-yos. Just remember that whatever size yo-yo you want, start with a circle twice that size. ☺
3. The last thing you see is another appliqué block. It has a 13" background of **fabric H**. There is a hand appliquéd (draw your own) on first of **fabric B** and a heart appliquéd over the hand of **fabric D**. This block can also be sized down to fit neatly in place. You will want it to match up to your tree block and moon phase block.

The final thing you need to add is a 6" border around the entire top once pieced. I had not yet decided which fabric my border will be.

I hope this helps you finish your project.

Again, sorry for the lack of cohesiveness in this set of directions, and the format being altered. I just wanted to get this out to you while I could.
